THE BANK OF MONGOLIA OFFICIAL INTRODUCTION

The Bank of Mongolia, the Central Bank of Mongolia, is a statutory institution established by the Government of Mongolia with the primary mandate of safeguarding the stability of the national currency, the Mongolian tögrög (MNT). Since its inception, the Bank has remained the cornerstone of the country's financial system, ensuring monetary and macroeconomic stability while fostering an environment conducive to sustainable economic growth. In the discharge of its duties, the Bank formulates and implements monetary policy, supervises and regulates the banking sector, and promotes the development of a sound, resilient, and inclusive financial system.

Core Functions of the Bank of Mongolia As defined by law, the Bank of Mongolia performs the following core functions:

Monetary Policy: Prepares annual monetary policy guidelines, outlining projections, priorities, and risks, which are submitted to Parliament by October 1 each year.

Currency Management: Has exclusive authority to design, issue, and circulate the tögrög, and manages the withdrawal of damaged notes and coins.

Banking Supervision: Licenses and regulates commercial banks, enforces prudential standards, and implements risk mitigation to ensure financial stability.

Fiscal Agent: Manages the unified treasury account and performs financial operations on behalf of the Government upon request from the Ministry of Finance.

Foreign Exchange Reserve Management: Administers Mongolia's foreign exchange reserves to ensure security, liquidity, and alignment with global standards.

Payment Systems: Operates and oversees the national interbank payment and settlement systems to support secure and efficient transactions.



MONGOLIA ASSET MANAGEMENT CORPORATION LLC

Mongolia Asset Management Corporation LLC (MAMCO) was established on August 30, 2017, by the Receivership Office of Savings Bank LLC to address real-world challenges in asset management while operating within Mongolia's existing legal framework. Initially launched to manage and recover non-performing loans (NPLs), MAMCO has since expanded its mandate to handle NPLs across both government and private sectors. On October 20, 2022, the Bank of Mongolia acquired a 10% ownership stake in the company. MAMCO's CEO, Enkhtur Minjuur, concurrently serves as the Receiver of Savings Bank. The Receiver of Savings Bank is appointed by the Bank of Mongolia, which also regularly supervises the operations of both Savings bank and MAMCO. In 2022, during the IPAF International Conference in Manila, MAMCO became a general member of the IPAF.

MAMCO is committed to becoming the leading entity in Mongolia for asset management and NPL recovery. This strategic approach is designed to address and mitigate financial risks, provide specialized asset management solutions, and attract investments. MAMCO aims to contribute positively to Mongolia's economic stability and understands what it has been doing helps to reduce total costs in connection with NPL resolutions and to lower the loan interest rates. Furthermore, MAMCO's efforts are expected to reduce the broader social impacts associated with asset management and support overall financial health in the region.



The Deposit Insurance Corporation of Mongolia (DICoM) is a state-owned, non-profit, and independent agency established under the Bank Deposit Insurance Law, enacted by Parliament on January 10, 2013. It officially commenced operations on June 14, 2013, with the primary mandate to protect depositors, promote public confidence, and contribute to financial stability in Mongolia.

DICoM administers the national deposit insurance scheme by collecting premiums from member banks, investing the deposit insurance fund, and executing timely payouts in the event of insured failures.

The Corporation is committed to aligning its operations with international best practices. It became the 72nd member of the International Association of Deposit Insurers (IADI) in 2013, joined the Financial Stability Council in 2018, and became an associate member of IPAF in 2023.

DICoM is currently headed by Acting CEO Mr. Baatarsuren Sukhbaatar.

laanbaatar (often abbreviated as UB) is the capital and largest city of Mongolia, home to nearly half of the country's population and the beating heart of its political, economic, and cultural life.

Nestled at 1,350 meters above sea level in the valley of the Tuul River and surrounded by majestic mountains, Ulaanbaatar is a city of striking contrasts. Here, centuries-old Buddhist monasteries stand beside sleek glass skyscrapers.

Nomadic traditions remain alive through vibrant festivals and markets, while a young, educated generation drives tech innovation, urban development, and cultural reinvention.

A BRIEF HISTORY

Founded in 1639 as a mobile Buddhist monastic center, the city eventually settled permanently in its current location in 1778. Originally named Khüree, it lkh later Ulaanbaatar. became "Red Hero", meaning in honor of Mongolia's independence revolution in the early 20th century.

TODAY, ULAANBAATAR IS:

The political center of Mongolia, hosting the Government Palace, State Great Khural (Parliament), and foreign embassies.

A cultural hub, with institutions like the Mongolian National Museum, Zanabazar Fine Arts Museum, and the

State Opera and Ballet Theatre.

The economic engine of the country, driving over 65% of national GDP, with strong mining, finance, services, and energy sectors.

ARRIVAL AIRPORT

All international flights arrive at Chinggis Khaan International Airport (UBN), located approximately 50 km southwest of Ulaanbaatar city center. The travel time to central hotels is approximately 1 hour by car.

AIRPORT RECEPTION

All IPAF participants will be welcomed by our official airport welcome team. Upon exiting the customs and immigration area:

People's Republic of China (unless holders of diplomatic and official passports)

Nepal, Sri Lanka (including holders of diplomatic and official passports)

CURRENCY EXCHANGE

- Hotels (limited)
- Commercial banks (recommended: KHAN Bank, Golomt Bank & XacBank)
- Licensed currency exchange offices

Avoid exchanging large sums at unlicensed vendors.

PAYMENT METHODS & BANKING

Credit Cards: Widely accepted (Visa, MasterCard, UnionPay, ApplePay)









ATMs: Available throughout Ulaanbaatar; most offer English-language options Carry some small cash for taxis, markets, and rural venues.

SHUTTLE SERVICE BETWEEN HOTELS & VENUES

To ensure smooth transportation for all participants, shuttle buses will operate between official IPAF hotels and the event venue.

ENTRY GUIDELINE

Power banks and e-cigarettes are not allowed across the Mongolian border.

If you are bringing sedative or prescription medication, please ensure it is accompanied by a doctor's note.

CLIMATE & WEATHER – AUGUST IN ULAANBAATAR

August is one of Mongolia's most pleasant months - dry, sunny, and moderate. However, Ulaanbaatar's high elevation (1,350m above sea level) brings significant temperature swings between day and night.

PRECAUTIONS

- Use ride-hailing apps (UBCab) instead of unregistered taxis, (UBCab offer English-language options) **UBCΛB**
- Avoid walking alone late at night.
- Be aware of pickpockets in crowded markets or bus stops.
- Carry a copy of your passport and hotel card when going out
- Emergency services are responsive.
